- A signed photo consent form must be submitted for each photo submitted
- The registration form must be signed and dated by a representative of the preschool, school or agency offering an after school program.
- The applicant must be 19 years of age or older.
- The applicant must check of the boxes at the bottom of the registration form that indicate he/she has submitted a photo consent form for each photo submitted and that he/she has read and agrees with the terms and conditions for the prize draw.
